

There is a Garage Sale Committee that helps pull this annual day together every year, and we do have a system, which has been perfected over the years.

1. We start the annual planning in mid-April, with the newsletters delivered door-to-door in the 3rd or 4th week in April with the Garage Sale Registration forms included
2. For those interested in having a sale, they need to bring their registration form & money to one of the people in the Garage Sale Committee listed on the Registration form in the first week of May. The registration form will have the exact date and Committee member addresses
3. Signs are placed in the neighborhood, reminding people to hand in their Registration forms
4. The Committee members type up the garage sale map- which will have address of sales and a brief description of items at individual homes- and have copies made (usually 25/home having a sale)
5. The Committee places Garage Sale ads in the Pioneer Press/Star Tribune, & SUN Newspaper, as well as Craigslist
6. Signs are placed at entrances to Lexington Square a few days before the sale
7. Maps are available for pick-up by people having sales on the Friday evening before the sale
